## A RESOLUTION RELEASING THE LIEN FOR ABATEMENT OF WEEDS ON THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 7535 OLD SPRINGVILLE ROAD, TRUSSVILLE, ALABAMA 35173

WHEREAS, 7535 Old Springville Road, Trussville, Alabama 35173 was found to be in violation of Ordinance 2010-03; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 2017-22 authorizing the abatement of weeds on the property located at 7535 Old Springville Road, Trussville, Alabama 35173, and abatement took place on August 8, 2017; and,

**WHEREAS,** the City Council passed Resolution 2017-34 on August 22, 2017, allowing the City Manager to file a lien of \$262.50 with the Jefferson County Probate Court; and,

**WHEREAS**, payment of \$262.50 was received by the City of Clay for the abatement lien.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council declares this lien to be satisfied and authorizes the City Manager to file this Resolution to release a lien for abatement of weeds at 7535 Old Springville Road, Trussville, Alabama 35173 with the Jefferson County Probate Court.
