WHEREAS, the invitation for bids was advertised with the opening date set forth in the bids and the City Council opened said bids in its regular City Council meeting of March 14, 2017, the total bids being as follows:

S & W Construction, LLC - \$5,000.00 TUC Pipeline - \$13,995.00

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Clay that S & W Construction, LLC is determined to be the lowest responsible bidder, the bid amount \$5,000.00 and that a contract will be awarded to such bidder.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to sign the contract in the name of the municipality, with the Manager's attestation to the Mayor's signature.

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 2016-68 on December 19, 2016 allowing the City Clerk to file a lien of \$167.50 with the Jefferson County Probate Court; and,

WHEREAS, payment of \$167.50 was received by the City of Clay for the abatement lien.

A RESOLUTION Opposing SB31 and HB58

WHEREAS, SB 31 (HB58) exempts prescription drug sales from the calculation of gross receipts business licenses; and

WHEREAS, businesses that provide goods and services within the municipal limits take advantage of the financial and other benefits they receive from the municipality including, but not limited to, the use of streets and roads, the potential use of law enforcement and fire protection, and the potential use of emergency medical transport; and

WHEREAS, revenue collected from business licensing provides approximately 25% of the revenue of the City of Clay and;

WHEREAS, monies collected from business licenses are used by the city to protect citizens by helping to provide services; and

WHEREAS, legislatively carving out this type of business from the coverage of municipal business licensing creates fundamental unfairness to other businesses is a slippery slope as other businesses and industries request similar legislative limitations on municipal license authority which could potentially cost the city a significant loss in revenue thereby resulting in devastating effects of the quality of life of our citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council declares it's strong opposition to SB31 (HB58) or any similar legislation that would restrict the city's authority to properly license business that is transacted within the municipality.
