## CITY COUNCIL MINUTES May 25th, 2021

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, May 25th, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows:

Present: Councilors Becky Johnson, Bo Johnson, Dean Kirkner, Dennis Locke, and Mayor Webster

Absent: Ben Thackerson

Councilor Dean Kirkner led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of May 11th, 2021. Councilor Dennis Locke made a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of May 11th, 2021, which was seconded by Councilor Bo Johnson and approved by a unanimous voice vote.

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Meeting Agenda. Councilor Locke made a motion to approve tonight's Meeting Agenda, which was seconded by Councilor Becky Johnson and approved by a unanimous voice vote.

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Consent Agenda. Councilor Becky Johnson made a motion to approve tonight's Consent Agenda, which was seconded by Councilor Kirkner and approved by a unanimous voice vote.

Under the **City Manager's report**, City Manager Ronnie Dixon reported the Fund Balances as follows: General Fund \$1,232,155.81, Vehicle Registration \$12,882.83, Contractor Bonds \$155,968.16, Capital Fund \$617,121.17, 4 & 5C Gas Fund \$204,727.02, 7 C Gas Fund \$133,906.42, Rebuild Alabama Gas Fund \$77,132.97, Building Fund \$0.00, Paving Supplement Fund \$256,840.98, Reserve Fund \$1,750,000.00, BBT Fund \$17,383.04, BP Sports Income \$20,941.52, BP Sports Expenses (\$21,532.39).

Under **Public Hearings** Mayor Webster introduced De-Annexation request 2021-01 for 6825 Candlewood Lane. The petition was heard at the 5/20/21 Planning and Zoning meeting and voted unanimously to deny. Present to speak was homeowner Jamie Burchfield. There was no one present to speak against the Petition.

Under **Resolutions, Ordinances, Orders and other Business.** Mayor Webster called for a motion to move to unanimous consent. *Councilor Locke made a motion to move into unanimous consent which was seconded by Councilor Bo Johnson.* The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: *Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Johnson, Kirkner, Locke and Mayor Webster.* 

Mayor Webster introduced De-Annex Ordinance 2021-01, 6825 Candlewood lane. Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to deny Ordinance 2021-02 which was seconded by Becky Johnson. The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Kirkner, Locke and Mayor Webster

Mayor Webster introduced Proclamation 2021-02, A proclamation recognizing Dr. P. Ronald Wilder on the occasion of his Pastor's Appreciation Celebration. *Councilor Becky Johnson made a motion to approve Proclamation 2021-02 which was seconded by Councilor Locke*. The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: *Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Kirkner, Locke and Mayor Webster* 



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Mayor Webster introduced Resolution 2021-09, a Resolution declaring weeds to be a public nuisance. Councilor Dennis Locke made a motion to deny Resolution 2021-09 which was seconded by Councilor Dean Kirkner. The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Kirkner, Locke and Mayor Webster

Mayor Webster introduced Resolution 2021-10, a Resolution declaring personal property to be a public nuisance. Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to deny Resolution 2021-10 which was seconded by Councilor Bo Johnson. The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Kirkner, Locke and Mayor Webster

Mayor Webster called an end to Unanimous Consent.

Under **Mayor and Council Comment,** Mayor Webster announced the Clay Chalkville High School graduation took place on 5/25/2021 with 270 graduates. The dates for the next city Council meetings need to be adjusted to 6/15 and 6/29. Mayor Webster called for the motion to approve the changes. *Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve the changes which was seconded by Councilor Becky Johnson.* 

**Councilor Becky Johnson** announced the Senior Center numbers are up and they are thrilled to be back. The Senior Center now has a vehicle assigned to them for daily food pickup.

Councilor Bo Johnson announced the first Movie Night was well attended. The next movie will be June 4.

**Councilor Dean Kirkner** introduced Chris Horn of Center Point Fire Department who announced the Center Point Fire District golf tournament July 26<sup>th</sup>.

Councilor Dennis Locke announced his resignation from the City Council due to his move out of Clay.

**Councilor Ben Thackerson** was not in attendance. Councilor Thackerson sent a note to be read by the Mayor announcing his move out of the City and offer his resignation from the Council.

Under **Public Comments,** Sharon Mays of 7701 Clayton Cove Parkway was present to speak. She requested a stop sign on Clayton Cove Parkway at Creekstone Circle. The request was denied due to the road being a through street. Mr. Dixon will direct deputies to patrol Clayton Cove parkway.

There being no further business, Mayor Webster called for a motion to adjourn. Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to adjourn which was seconded by Councilor Bo Johnson. The meeting adjourned at 6:33 pm.
