CITY COUNCIL MINUTES February 27th, 2024

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, February 27th, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Councilor Bo Johnson led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows: Councilors Becky Johnson, Bo Johnson, Dean Kirkner, Chris Nail, Orletta Rush, Mayor Webster

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of February 13th, 2024. *Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of February 13th, 2024, which was seconded by Councilor Orletta Rush and approved by a unanimous voice vote.*

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Meeting Agenda. *Councilor Orletta Rush made a motion to approve the Meeting Agenda, which was seconded by Councilor Dean Kirkner and approved by a unanimous voice vote.*

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Consent Agenda. *Councilor Becky Johnson made a motion to approve tonight's Consent Agenda, which was seconded by Councilor Orletta Rush.* The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the following result: *Yeas: Johnson, Johnson, Dean, Nail, Rush, and Webster.*

Under the City Manager's report, Mr. Dixon updated the Council on the following: Clay Chalkville High School Band will be traveling to Orlando, the city has given the school \$30,000 to supplement the trip cost. The Birmingham Mayors' Prayer Breakfast will be held on May 2nd at 8:00 am. Clay Pinson Prayer Breakfast, May 3rd at 8:00 am at Grayson Valley Country Club. Alabama Open Pickleball Tournament to be held March 27th-30th.

Under Public Hearings Ordinance 2024-01, An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 2018-01. The Planning and Zoning Committee recommended change/update be approved.

City Manager Ronnie Dixon introduced Resolution 2024-02. A Resolution Declaring Weeds to be a Public Nuisance. *Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-02 which was seconded by Councilor Orletta Rush.* The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: *Yeas: Councilors, Johnson, Kirkner, Dean, Nail, Rush, and Mayor Webster.*

End unanimous consent.

Under Mayor and Council Comments, Mayor Webster announced the planning of a Championship Parade for Clay Chalkville High School including academic and athletic.

Councilor Becky Johnson: reported the Senior Center is doing well with approximately sixteen in attendance daily.

Councilor Bo Johnson: had no report.
