CITY COUNCIL MINUTES May 24th, 2022

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, May 24th, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon, served as recorder.
