Whereas, the people of Clay, Alabama knew Christina Nicole Heichelbech as an "awesome "daughter and loving sister; and

**Whereas,** on Monday, January 23, 2012, Christina Nicole Heichelbech of Clay, Alabama, was killed from injuries sustained during an F3 tornado that struck her community; and

Whereas, all of the citizens of Clay, Alabama, mourn the death of Christina Nicole Heichelbech and the loss to her family, friends, and community.
