CITY COUNCIL MINUTES July 14, 2020

The City Council of the City of Clay Alabama met digitally, pursuant to Governor Ivey's Order, for a regularly scheduled City Council meeting at 6:30 pm on July 14, 2020. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows:

Absent: none

Councilor Bo Johnson led in prayer.

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Pre-Council and Regular Council meeting minutes of June 23, 2020. Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve the Pre-Council and Regular Council meeting minutes of June 23, 2020 which was seconded by Councilor Dennis Locke. The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows:

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve tonight's Meeting Agenda.

Under the City Manager's report, City Manager Ronnie Dixon reported on the following:

- 1. Reviewed plans for fall sports
- 2. Splash pad will not open until Spring 2021 because of rain delays and COVID-19.
- 3. The City received prices for repaying some roads and will begin doing so shortly if asphalt is available.
- 5. Fund Balances: General Fund \$795,137.92; Vehicle Fund \$23,104.98; Contractor Bonds \$155,998.16; Capital Funds \$468,957.81; 4/5 Cent Gas Fund \$137,741.34; 7 Cent Gas Fund \$77,167.43; Rebuild Alabama (10 Cent Gas) Fund \$30,887.15; Building fund \$425,326.97; Paving Supplement Fund \$256,840.98; Reserve Fund \$1,100,000.00; BBT fund \$23,169.20; Ballpark Sports Income \$23,957.63; Ballpark Sports Expenses (\$24,068.23)

Under Resolutions, Ordinances, Orders and other Business, Mayor Webster called for a motion to move to unanimous consent. Councilor Becky Johnson a motion to move into unanimous consent which was seconded by



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Councilor Dennis Locke. The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Johnson, Kirkner, Locke, Thackerson and Mayor Webster.

Mayor Webster introduced Ordinance 2020-05, An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance 2020-03. *Councilor Dennis Locke made a motion to approve Ordinance 2020-05 which was seconded by Councilor Dean Kirkner.* The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Johnson, Kirkner, Locke, Thackerson and Mayor Webster.

Mayor Webster introduced Resolution 2020-11, A Resolution Appointing the City Manager to Perform the Duties for Holding a Municipal Election as Required by State Law. *Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-11 which was seconded by Councilor Ben Thackerson.* The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Johnson, Kirkner, Locke, Thackerson and Mayor Webster.

Mayor Webster introduced Resolution 2020-12, A Resolution Declaring Weeds to be a Public Nuisance. *Councilor Dean Kirkner made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-12 which was seconded by Councilor Ben Thackerson.* The motion was put before the Council and a roll call vote was conducted with the results as follows: Yeas: Councilors Johnson, Johnson, Kirkner, Locke, Thackerson and Mayor Webster.

Mayor Webster recognized Mr. Gene Coleman of Center Point Fire District who reviewed fire district statistics.

There being no further business, Councilor Bo Johnson made a motion to adjourn which was seconded by Councilor Becky Johnson and approved by a unanimous voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:58 pm.
