CITY COUNCIL MINUTES November 14th, 2023

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, November 14th, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Councilor Bo Johnson led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows: Councilors Becky Johnson, Bo Johnson, Dean Kirkner, Chris Nail, and Mayor Webster

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of October 24th, 2023. Councilor Kirkner made a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of October 24th, 2023, which was seconded by Councilor Chris Nail and approved by a unanimous voice vote.
