CITY COUNCIL MINUTES January 10th, 2023

The City Council of the City of Clay met in regular session on Tuesday, January 10th, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. at Clay City Hall. Mayor Webster presided over the meeting and Ronnie Dixon served as recorder.

Councilor Bo Johnson led in prayer. Mayor Webster led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Webster called the meeting to order and roll call was conducted as follows: Councilors Becky Johnson, Bo Johnson, Chris Nail, Orletta Rush and Mayor Webster Absent: Councilor Dean Kirkner

Mayor Webster called for a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of December 20, 2022. Councilor Chris Nail made a motion to approve the Council meeting minutes of December 20, 2022, which was seconded by Councilor Bo Johnson and approved by a unanimous voice vote.

Under the **City Manager's report**, Ronnie Dixon read the account balances: General Fund \$1,575,952.56, Vehicle Registration \$6,177.92, Contractor Bonds \$155,911.16, Capital Fund \$1,654,371.69, 4 & 5C Gas Fund \$228,856.14, 7 C Gas Fund \$67,984.02, Rebuild Alabama Gas Fund \$163,918.63, Building Fund \$0.00, Paving Supplement Fund \$236,840.98, Reserve Fund \$2,929,486.65, BBT Fund \$61,596.88, BP Sports Income \$24,806.42, BP Sports Expenses (\$9,154.28).

Public Hearings were held for properties 789 Chestnut Drive and 6791 Old Springville Road. Residents for both properties were present and requested more time for clean up. The hearing was tabled until January 24th, 2003.

Under Mayor and Council Comment
