A Proclamation to Observe Constitution Week

Whereas, September 17, 2012, marks the 225th anniversary of the signing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary; and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

Whereas, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week.

Now, Therefore, the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week and all citizens are encouraged to reaffirm the ideals of the Framers of the Constitution by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
